24-Hour Access Rules & Regulations

- Please allow up to 48 hours for your 24-Hour Access Application to be processed.
- All Applicants will be required to complete a 24-Hour Access Orientation with the Fremont Community Recreation Complex before being granted access.
- Your 24-Hour Access privileges may not be shared with anyone. Sharing privileges will result in the suspension or termination of your annual membership, without refund.
- Applicants must be 18 years of age.
- 24-Hour Access is limited to Annual Members, in good standing, only. Seasonal Passes and Walking Passes are not eligible for 24-Hour Access.
- Public areas of the facility are under video surveillance and are monitored by Fremont PD during non-business hours.
- 24-Hour Access is available for the gym, free-weight room, track, cardio areas and machine weights. The pool, ice rink and locker rooms are not available during 24-Hour Access.
- Competitive, or group play, is not permitted on the gymnasium floor. Equipment for the gym is not provided during 24-Hour Access (basketball, volleyball, etc.).
- Members must enter their membership ID to utilize 24-Hour Access, even if the door is opened by another member. Failure to use your membership ID will result in suspension or termination of your annual membership, without refund.
- No staff will be available during non-business hours. During this time, it is recommended that you have a workout partner. Each member must have a 24-Hour Access Membership. No guests are allowed.
- The facility is equipped with emergency alert necklaces. It is highly recommended that these are utilized during non-business hours. Each necklace, when pressed, will dispatch police and EMS. These are to be used in emergency situations only.
- 24-Hour Access is subject to change due to special events or facility maintenance needs. Notifications will be posted with as much advance notice as possible.
- The Recreation Superintendent may update or change these rules at any time. Initial: _____

Participation Waiver and Release Form:

I am applying for a 24-hour membership to the Fremont Community Recreation Complex, hereafter referred to as "the facility". I am aware that there will be no supervision or assistance during 24-hour access and that if I am injured, become unconscious, suffer a stroke or heart attack, that there will likely be no one to respond to my emergency and this facility has no duty to provide assistance for me. Even though the facility is equipped with surveillance cameras, alert buttons and is monitored by the Fremont Police Department; it is likely that if I require immediate assistance, none will be provided. As such, I understand that having a workout partner accompany me is recommended by the facility.

I am voluntarily participating in the use of the facility and assume all risks of injury, illness or death. I also agree that neither the facility nor the City of Fremont shall be held responsible for any loss or damage to personal property.

This waiver and release of liability includes, without limitation, all injuries which may occur, regardless of negligence, as a result of, (1) my use of the amenities and equipment in the facility, (2) sudden and unforeseen malfunction of any equipment and (3) my slipping or falling while in the facility, including adjacent sidewalks and parking areas.

I acknowledge that I have carefully read this waiver and release and fully understand that it is a release of liability. I expressly agree to release and discharge the facility, The City of Fremont and all affiliates, employees, agents, representatives, heirs, or assigns, from any and all claims or causes of action. I agree to voluntarily give up or waive any right that I may otherwise have to bring legal action against the facility or the City of Fremont for negligence, personal injury or property damage.

I understand that 24-Hour access to the facility is a privilege which can be revoked by the Recreation Superintendent at any time, for any reason, and without warning. I understand that if I allow unauthorized persons into the facility, the City may pursue legal action against me and my membership may be suspended or terminated ,without refund.

Member Guidelines



About 24-Hour Access

- 24-Hour Access is a part of your annual membership. All Annual Members, including Bank Draft and Silver Sneakers members, are eligible to apply for 24-Hour Access provided their membership is considered in good standing.
- 24-Hour Access is only available to members 18 years of age and older.
- The gymnasium, free-weight room, track, cardio areas and machine weights are available during non-business hours. Access to the pool, ice rink and locker rooms is prohibited.
- Non-competitive, non-group play is allowed in the gymnasium. Equipment will not be provided by the facility during non-business hours.
- Lighting within the gymnasium, and 2nd floor is controlled by a timer in order to conserve energy. Normal lighting during business hours will not be available.

Gaining Access

- All interested members must complete a 24-Hour Access Application to be considered. Once your application has been approved, an orientation with the Fremont Community Recreation Complex staff must be completed before utilizing your 24-Hour Access privileges.
- Entry to the facility during non-business hours will be through the middle gymnasium doors. During normal business hours, 24-Hour Members must check-in with the Front Desk. You must not use the middle doors for access during normal business hours.
- When exiting the facility, members must do so through the middle gymnasium doors. All other exits are equipped with security monitoring devices and will trigger the alarm. These exits are to be used only in the event of an emergency.

My Responsibilities

- You must enter your membership ID each time you utilize the facility. Your membership ID cannot be shared with anyone. No guests are permitted to use the facility during non-business hours. Failure to abide by these regulations will result in the suspension or termination of your annual membership, without refund.
- A workout partner is highly recommended during non-business hours. If you choose to workout without a partner, the use of emergency alert necklaces are highly recommended. Alert necklaces will dispatch Fremont PD and EMS and are to be used only in life threatening emergency situations.
- All normal facility rules must be abided by during non-business hours. Rules for various workout areas are posted throughout the facility.
